Suicide in the Clinical Practice of Gestalt Psychotherapy Presenter / Karolina Krysinska, PhD Wednesday 10th November 2021 9.30am -1.30pm

Suicide-related presentations are often experienced as very challenging and distressing for all therapists.

This interactive training will provide insight into the complex nature of suicidality, and how suicidal ideation and behaviour can be understood and addressed in the context of Gestalt theory and practice. It will also provide information on the needs and resources available for family members and others who support a person at risk of suicide, and for people bereaved by suicide

Methodology

The seminar will include some theory or psychoeducation, an opportunity to share experience and dilemmas around working with clients expressing suicidal ideation, and their families, and an overview of Gestalt thinking on this topic.
